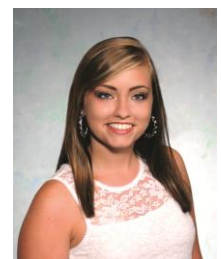

Local Organizations Receive Funding for Summer Programs

For the fourth consecutive year, GCMHF has donated bicycle helmets to Waynesburg Borough to be distributed to local children completely free of cost. The 72 helmets are certified to be worn for bicycling or skateboarding and are available in a variety of sizes, and may be obtained by contacting the borough office.



The borough also received a \$5,000 grant for its six-week summer day camp. The camp is held at one of the four community parks along Greene and High Street and is structured with activities and lesson plans each day. The program is dedicated to providing fun, educational activities and includes topics on health, fitness, nature and wildlife.



Waynesburg Prosperous and Beautiful also received a seasonal grant in order to hire an onsite manager to oversee the Farmers Market, held each Wednesday throughout the summer on Church Street in Waynesburg. The Farmer's Market is entering its tenth year and emphasizes eating healthy and uses an educational program called Buy Local, Buy Greene.
